

Here are some basics concerning our server:

In order to protect you from unwanted mails, our system filters all mails sent to [kinderstube-list@biculturalfamily.org](mailto:kinderstube-list@biculturalfamily.org)

1) To protect you from unwanted junk mails, only members of the distribution list can send mails to the to [kinderstube-list@biculturalfamily.org](mailto:kinderstube-list@biculturalfamily.org). This is the reason why you can only send an email from the same address which you are signed up. For example, if I am signed onto the list as [judith@mainone.de](mailto:judith@mainone.de) then I can not send messages to the list from [judithmainone@hotmail.com](mailto:judithmainone@hotmail.com). You can tell which email address is valid based on which email address you receive these Kinderstube emails.

2) The attachments you sent to the list must not exceed a certain limit. This way we can ensure that your inboxes doesn't get clogged by Kinderstuben mails

3) Only mails that are sent "only" to the Kinderstube get through, not mails that also address other recipients. This makes it harder to just send something out unless specifically intended for the list (e.g. viral spam). We tried to see if we could find a way to change the settings for this but we couldn't find anything. Your mails get through if you just send it to the Kinderstube list and not to the list plus others.

4) If you do not receive Kinderstuben mails or if you know of someone who says they are not receiving any emails from the Kinderstube list, then please have them email myself ([judith@mainone.de](mailto:judith@mainone.de) or [info@seattlekinderstube.org](mailto:info@seattlekinderstube.org)) and I'll double check on our end to make sure that they are still handled as "active accounts".
